2021 Membership, Race & Practice Fee Schedule

Annual Full Memberships:

Active or Family Membership \$350.00

Limited Membership:

A limited membership is available for a driver that wishes only to participate in three race weekends consisting of Saturday practice, and Sunday race day, and the fee is \$150.00 plus race day fees.

Race Day:

Senior Classes- one driver; one kart class entry - \$ 85.00

Junior Classes- one driver; one kart class entry - \$ 75.00

Note: For every additional kart class entry for either senior or junior classes, a discount of \$20.00 will be applied.

Practice Day (Test & Tune) - \$10.00 per driver \$25.00 family (max)

Payment of Fees:

Annual membership fees are to be paid by cheque (payable to Manitoba Karting Association) or Sign up when membership forms are submitted to the MKA Secretary before Race 1.

For 2021: Race day, practice day and limited membership fees are to be paid online through motorsportsreg.com Click the "Race Registration" button on the MKA website and follow the instructions.

Annual Volunteer Commitment

At the time of payment of an Annual Full Membership fee, three post-dated cheques (May 1st, June 1st and July 1st) of \$120.00 each, made payable to the Manitoba Karting Association, are required. The volunteer cheques will only be cashed if a member is unable to fulfill his or her annual volunteer commitment to the MKA of three full race day events.

Note: a member who does not provide the required three post-dated volunteer cheques, prior to the first race event, will not be allowed to participate in that race event or subsequent race events, until the volunteer cheques are provided to the MKA Secretary.

In consideration of being granted benefits of membership in the Manitoba Karting Association, herein known as MKA:

1. THE UNDERSIGNED, for myself, my personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns, DO:
 - (a) HEREBY AGREE TO ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY FOR ALL ACTS OR ACTIVITIES of myself, my drivers, assistants, and crew for any and all damage or injury that may be caused by any or all of us or by our kart, motor, properties or possessions in any way growing out of or resulting from the operation of my equipment and/or as a result of us participating in any and all events or functions associated with MKA.
 - (b) HEREBY AGREE to be bound by all of the rules of the MKA and agree that decisions of its officials and/or interpretations of its rules will be governed exclusively by the administrative review and appeal procedure set forth in such rules.
 - (c) HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE THE MKA, as an association including all of its corporate, elected and appointed officials, all members of committees, referees, and inspectors, volunteers, its individual members, its agencies of government which control essential land sites, financiers and firms which render essential services gratis, including all officers, agents, and employees of the foregoing and additional volunteer workers assisting in sanctioned MKA race, practice and/or event activities, all herein after referred to as RELEASES, from or for any and all liability to me, my personal representatives, heirs, next of kin, successors and assigns, for all loss or damage for bodily injury, death or damage to property of the undersigned, which in any way grows out of or results from MKA race or event activities or part thereof, during the actual sanctioned period and whether any such claim may be based upon alleged active or passive negligence whether caused by the release or otherwise, or participation in the wrong, or upon any alleged breach of statutory duties or obligation, and
 - (d) HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releases and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.
 - (e) HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releases or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing, or working for or for any purpose participating in the event
 - (f) THE UNDERSIGNED EXPRESSLY ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT THE ACTIVITIES OF THE EVENT ARE VERY DANGEROUS AND INVOLVE THE RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY AND/OR DEATH AND/OR PROPERTY DAMAGE: THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees the foregoing release, waiver and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the Law of the Province of Manitoba in which the event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance, not withstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
 - (g) HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE, that I have no right, property or interest in any radio or television broadcast, motion pictures, still photographs, tape or sound reproduction taken, made, transmitted, reproduced, or used for any purpose of any MKA sanctioned events, including practice, qualification, the race awards ceremonies or other events associated with the racing event, also including, but not limited to pictures and sound of me alone or with other persons, with or without racing equipment, as well as any and all receipts therefrom, and any transcription thereof.
 - (h) IN CONSIDERATION OF THEIR PROMOTIONAL EFFORT ON BEHALF OF THE SPORT, I hereby assign all commercial communication and broadcast rights to the MKA, and do declare it as my lawful agent and representative regarding such rights. I AGREE the MKA, or its assigns, on a non-exclusive basis, may use my name and pictures, including pictures of my racing equipment, and pictures taken at any sanctioned event for publicity purposes.

MKA PRACTICE POLICY- USE OF TRACK FOR NON-RACE DAY PRACTICE SESSIONS

Testing and tuning is an on-track activity that does not involve wheel-to-wheel competition, races of any kind, or rewards of any kind.

1. During Testing and Tuning sessions, the track must be supervised by a Club Supervisor at all times it is being used, regardless of the number of karts on the track. For clarity, it is not permitted that a single person alone can take a kart onto the race track without a first-aid trained Club Supervisor present.
2. The Club Supervisor in charge of the practice session will wear a safety vest at all times to identify themselves as the person in charge of the session. All participants must obey the direction of the Club Supervisor at all times. Any participant not following the instruction of the Club Supervisor may be asked to suspend their practice session and may face penalty as determined by the MKA Executive.
3. Testing and Tuning is available only to permanent and temporary (daily) members in good standing with the Manitoba Karting Association, who individually have signed a waiver.
4. All participants, not just the driver, must sign a waiver and release, preferably an annual release with membership, or each time the race track facility is used.
5. Parent/Guardian release waivers are applicable where minors are involved.
6. No more than 10 karts on the race track at one time.
7. Junior and Senior karts shall not be on the track at the same time except where it is for instructional purposes only and has been approved by the Club Supervisor present.
8. Wheel-to-wheel competition is not permitted.
9. Non-competitive passing is allowed.
10. The Club Supervisor must be able to call 911. A connected land line phone or functioning cellular phone is permitted.
11. A fire extinguisher and first aid kit must be accessible by the Club Supervisor.
12. A vehicle must be readily available to the Club Supervisor to provide assistance where necessary while awaiting response from the 911 call.
13. The Club Supervisor in charge of the practice must notify the MKA via email to manitobakarting@gmail.com before opening the track for practice. All participants must pay the practice fee online in advance or make other payment arrangements with the MKA prior to attending any practice session.
14. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in penalty or loss of club privileges up to and including suspension of membership as determined by the MKA Executive.

MANITOBA KARTING ASSOCIATION – CODE OF CONDUCT

It is the intention of this guideline to promote fair competition, respect and sportsmanship for all participants within the MKA. The intent of the Code of Conduct is to positively influence the behavior of Drivers, Crew members and Parents. As well, to identify what MKA has determined to be expected and acceptable behavior within our club.

MEMBERS' PLEDGE

1. I will follow and abide by all rules of karting as established by MKA do so in the spirit of kart racing.
2. I will control my temper- arguing, fighting or "mouthing-off" can spoil the activity of everyone involved in kart racing.
3. I will support all efforts to remove verbal abuse or physical abuse from race events.
4. I will never ridicule or yell derogatory remarks at my or any child, a track official, or another parent.
5. I will respect all driving opponents and members of their race teams.
6. I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteers who give their time to the MKA.
7. I will show graciousness in winning or losing and will remember that winning isn't everything, that having fun and improving performance and doing my best is also important.
8. I will acknowledge and applaud the driving and performances of my opponents.
9. I will remember that track officials are there to help me and I will never question a track official's judgment or honesty in public. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.
10. I will race karts because I want to, not because others want me to.
11. I will remember that Drivers participates in karting for their enjoyment. I would never force a Driver to participate in karting.
12. If applicable, I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning and offer praise for competing fairly and hard after every race so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a race.
13. I will remember that children learn by example. I will applaud the driving and performances by both my child and their driving opponents and teach my child to show graciousness in winning or losing.
14. I will be responsible for the conduct of my guests at my races.
15. I will be responsible for my child's crew members, encouraging them to respect and abide by the Parents Code of Conduct.
