#### 2. ASN National Licence Categories and Classes

National A	Driver-Kart	<p><b>All Senior, Shifter and Masters Classes</b></p> <p>The applicant must have competed in a minimum of 6 club or regional races within the previous 24 months to obtain a National A licence. Minimum Age restriction:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Briggs &amp; Stratton Senior, Rok, &amp; Rotax Senior, Rok Shifter and Briggs &amp; Stratton Masters 14<sup>th</sup> birthday during the current calendar year</li> <li>• Rotax DD2 15<sup>th</sup> birthday during the current calendar year</li> <li>• <b>Rok Masters, Rok Shifter Masters &amp; B&amp;S Masters 30<sup>th</sup> birthday during the current calendar year or 200 lbs. or more.</b></li> <li>• Rotax DD2 Masters <del>and Rok Shifter Masters</del> 32<sup>nd</sup> birthday during the current calendar year</li> </ul>

#### 2.3. ASN Driver Qualifications

a) Bona-fide proof of age must be available at all times and is required to be shown to a Race Official if requested.

A driver can compete in any class that has the same grade of licence that they have been issued.

For example, a driver with a B licence can run in any class that requires a B licence. Once a driver moves up a class, for example from D to C or C to B or B to A they will not be eligible to go back to the lower class. **The one exception to this rule is that B&S Cadet and Rok Mini drivers can compete, with a C or D Licence, in these two classes only without penalty.**
